SUPERFLOOR

Melbourne Connect's dynamic hub, spanning over 3,000sqm has the capacity to host up to 1,000 people. Featuring state-of-the-art conference and event spaces, the Superfloor is where leading researchers, start-ups and corporate partners collaborate and innovate.



THE CREATOR SPACE

Innovation starts with early idea testing. Serving over 10,000 engineering students, this onsite fabrication lab is open to the innovation precinct community for prototyping and experimentation.





THE SUPERFLOOR

Located at the heart of Melbourne Connect, The Superfloor is a 3,600sqm collaboration space designed by leading architect Woods Bagot. More than just a venue, it is an immersive environment that connects the precinct community through year-round events, workshops, and industry engagements. The Superfloor sets a new benchmark for spaces dedicated to collaboration and activations, offering a flexible, open layout that fosters connectivity.


Overlooking the Womin-Djerring (oculus), The Superfloor features diverse event and meeting spaces available for hire, including The Forum, The Launchpad, and The Lab. Whether you're hosting a conference, panel discussion, networking event, or workshop, the Superfloor provides a unique setting to suit your event's needs. Common areas are also available for exhibitions and after-hours special events.

For those visiting or looking to host informal meetings, the Superfloor offers seating areas around the Superfloor Café, which is open weekdays with free Wi-Fi available. Meeting rooms are bookable via the concierge team, who are available weekdays from 8:30am to 5:30pm to assist with visitor queries and bookings.

THE FORUM

The Forum is a highly versatile space on The Superfloor, capable of hosting up to 400 people in a theatre setup, 200 for dining, or split into three smaller rooms with a 100-person capacity. Ideal for events seminars, presentations and workshops, its facilities rival those of a high-end, purpose-built conference venue.

The Forum has views into Science Gallery Melbourne's atrium gallery, providing guests with access to beautiful displays of art installations.



The Launch Pad is a dynamic space for creating, prototyping, pitching, and testing. As The Superfloor's central hub, it fosters ideation and knowledge exchange among the precinct community, The University of Melbourne, industry leaders, and visiting professionals.

With a 70-person capacity, its open-plan layout encourages interaction and accommodates activities like product demos, investor pitches, panel discussions, and prototyping sessions.


Next to The Launch Pad, The Lab offers a flexible space for exhibitions, networking, and casual gatherings.

- Touch panel control system for room lighting


